

## The Gospel of Your Salvation

Despite the fact that church members may find salvation a very common word, so common in fact that it may even be taken for granted at times, it is possible that others are asking, “The good news of my salvation? I didn’t know I had any; what is it is it anything like a plantation? How much of it is there? Where is it? How did I come by it? Tell me about it.”

Now I’m not being facetious or funny, it’s just a matter of truth that a lot of people have never once thought of salvation. It just isn’t something that’s talked a lot in their circle of friends and associates. Life seems to be going on for them about like it does for everyone else, at least as far as they know. They seem to be doing very well; they are young and healthy; they have about everything they want or need. And if they don’t have, they can get it. So what’s the good news of salvation? Well, my friend, let me tell you about it.

The word salvation literally means “deliverance and/or protection.” It is one of those words like “gospel” that could be used with regard to material things—like deliverance and protection from poverty, or danger or suffering of some kind. But we have reserved its use almost exclusively for religious purposes. It is a good Bible word, used 164 times in the Scriptures.

Salvation comes from the same root as the words save and savior—and even the name Jesus. So it is no surprise that the angel announced the birth of Jesus of Nazareth in Luke 2:11, “for today in the city of David there has been born for you a savior who is Christ the Lord.” When we talk with people about being saved or the state of being saved, some are confused because they don’t know anything about being unsaved. They are in spiritual danger at some time but totally unaware of it. To talk to us about a way of escape would have been a waste of time because they weren’t even conscious of their peril.

Why do any of us need salvation? The answer is simple because of sin. Man was created with a sense of “oughtness,” so that when we mature to the point of responsibility for our actions, we became aware that certain forms of behavior are “oughts” for us. We ought to do them. Other actions or behavioral patterns are unacceptable and we ought not to do them, of course man is not left to himself to determine those behavioral forms that are right and wrong; he is given instructions in the word of God. All behavior that conflicts with God’s teaching is called “sin.”

As we go about our daily lives, let’s try to understand the thoughts of the people around us. We live in a world that is in desperate need of the gospel (good news –dynamite–) of Jesus Christ. We are tasked with the job of sharing that good news with those around us. May we share the Love of Jesus
