

Three Distinct Divisions of Authority

In the text in First Corinthians 11:3, Paul delivered very important information that was critical for the church. "But I want you to know that the head of every man is Christ, the head of woman is man, and the head of Christ is God." Paul here notes three distinct divisions of authority. As we study this verse let us look at authority as God designed. Mankind has struggled with authority since the beginning of time. Sin is in the world because man was not willing to accept the authority of God and wanted to be wise like God. In our day people fight for authority all the time. Many times you will here the phrase too many chiefs and not enough Indians. This is the idea that too many people want to be leaders and not many want to be followers. God expects both leaders and followers in the church of Christ.

First, "The head of every man is Christ." As seen in this passage, men are subject to Christ Jesus as our authority. If we take this approach in life, we will have a better life and glorious eternity. The apostle Paul says in Ephesians 1:22, "And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church." It is wonderful to know that God sent his son to die for us and put him over the church. As Christians we can look unto Christ for leadership and guidance. This can be done through the word of God. Colossians 1:18, "And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the first-born from the dead, that in all things He may have the prominence." As men, we need to understand that we are under Christ Jesus authority.

Second, "The head of woman is man." In our day and age this statement does not fit our culture. First Peter 3:7, "Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered." Peter gives directions to the husband about how to treat his wife. Treat her with understanding, giving honor to her. Husbands should always remember their responsibility. Peter adds, as to the weaker vessel. No matter how strong physically God has made woman to be, she is the physically weaker vessel, and He has given husband the task of taking care of them. At times, people don't always follow God's plan.

Finally, "God is the head of Christ." Even Christ must answer to God. This helps us to understand that there is a chain of command. We know that God and Christ Jesus have our best interest at heart. We know they will guide us in the correct manner of life and eternity. Let's follow the authority of the scripture through God and Christ. May we be blessed as we follow Christ!

Broken Toilets and Broken Souls

It's not an extremely rare occasion for a passenger jet to have to return to the airport due to a mechanical issue. However, when a Norwegian jet bound for Germany reversed course in late January of this year due to malfunctioning toilets, it was a backtrack filled with irony. The plane, you see, was carrying 85 plumbers.

With 85 certified plumbers on board, you might think someone could have fixed the broken toilet and allowed the plane to continue its journey. The problem was that the affected parts could only be accessed from outside the airplane. Though the men had the strength, knowledge, and power to fix the problem, they had no access to the heart of the error.

There is a far more powerful force in this world, one that can fix the broken inner parts of our souls, and that is the word of God. It has the power to save us (Romans 1:16), diagnose our weaknesses (Hebrews 4:12), and equip us for every good work (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

The problem, as in the case of the airplane, is often one of access to the heart. God's word is more than powerful enough to do the job, but we have to let it in! David said he had hidden God's word in his heart so that he might not sin against God (Psalms 119:11). Will you resolve to read, study, and meditate upon God's word, and allow it to mend all of your broken pieces today?
