

**The First Sin**

The events of Adam, Eve and Satan in the garden of Eden affect all of us today. As we look at the events of the garden of Eden, we notice the results from those events. God announced the punishment first for Satan, the one that spread the first lie and encouraged the sin. The text identifies the sin of man first (3:9-11), then the sin of the woman (3:12), and finally, the sin of the serpent (3:13). The judgments were pronounced on the serpent first, on the woman second, and on the man last.

With Satan, there was no attempt made to bring him to repentance. There was no attempt to let Satan explain the sin or temptation. God knew the heart of Satan. The serpent would be put on his belly, and he would eat dust all the days of his life. Secondly, "God would put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed." "The first part of the curse, then, could refer to the hostility that exists between the woman's seed (mankind) and the serpent's seed (the world of serpents), which causes humans to destroy the heads of snakes before they can be bitten on their heels" (Grasham 135). The last curse God gives to Satan is, "He shall bruise you on the head, And you shall bruise him on the heel." The punishment would be fatal for Satan but only a bruise for those who go against Satan. Romans 16:20, "And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen."

"God's judgment on the woman disrupted her created role. She was created to be Adam's wife, a helper who corresponded to him; and she was to become the mother of his children( 2:18, 23, 24)" (Grasham, 137). God used children to multiply the birth pain as a punishment for the sin that was committed. Secondly, the women desire would be for her husband and he would rule over her. Because of the deception in the garden, God makes sure that the woman understands God wants the man to be the head of the family.

God's judgment on the man brings out the fact that Adam listened to the woman. He did not follow that plan that God had for him but became obedient to the woman. God point this out as he pronounced the curse because of sin. God goes on to point to the fact that Adam listened to the woman directly over the command of the Lord. The punishment would be that man would now understand work. Man would realize sweat on his face as he would need to work to eat the rest of his life. But the most significant punishment of all come last. God said that he would return man to the dust of the earth which he was taken. That human body that God had created from the dust of the ground would begin to age and deteriorate.

God provides a way of out of sin through his son Jesus Christ. John 3:17, "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved." God's Grace is Good!
