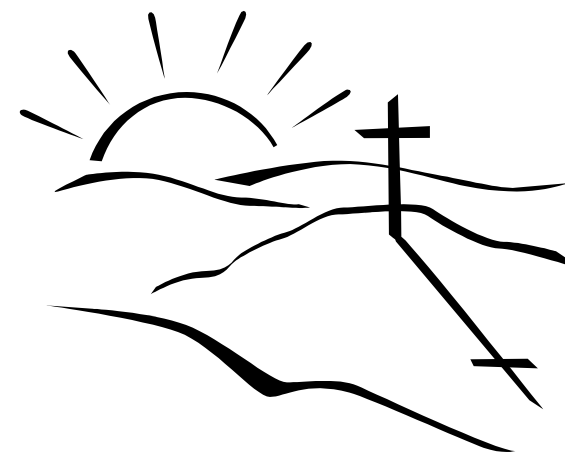

Who can go to Heaven?

When looking at the question of who can go to heaven, we must turn to the Bible to see the answers of who can go to heaven and who will not be able to go to heaven. In our world, you will be hard pressed to find someone who says they do not want to go to heaven. The problem becomes, even though just about everyone you meet will say they want to go to heaven, few want to live their life the way the Bible teaches to get to heaven.

First, we will look at those that the Bible says will not be able to go to heaven if their behavior continues. *First Corinthians 6:9-10*, "O do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornication, nor idolater, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God." As we read through the warning of 6:9 and the catalog of sins, it is important to keep before us the function of the material in this section. Because of sexual immorality being committed by believers, it must be the case that Paul is warning believers that their sinful behavior will disqualify them from inheriting God's kingdom. There are many sins on this list that we all recognize and may know of people who have committed these or maybe at one time you have engaged in some of these sins. We are reminded that we are all in the same situation. Romans 3:23, "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Paul would talk about being slaves to sin as could be described with any of the sins mentioned above. In Romans 6:20 the apostle says, "For when you were slaves if sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. Therefore what benefit were you then deriving from the things of which you are now ashamed? For the outcome of those things is death." We learn that sins lead us to death. This death is not the physical death that we know, but spiritual death.

Second, we will look at those that will go to heaven. Notice the next verse in First Corinthians 6:11, the apostle Paul says, "Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God." The NIV translates this "And that is what some of you were." We all live in a world of sin, but if you are a Christian according to the New Testament, we are forgiven of sin. The apostle resorts here to his "before-and-after" illustration, this time to highlight the contrast between their prior exclusion from God's inheritance and their current state of purity, holiness, and justification. Some would define justification as "just if I never sinned." Notice the three aorist verbs "washed, sanctified, and justified." The most cogent interpretation relates washed to the believer's participation in water baptism. Sanctified is a pervasive term in Paul's writings and is a work of God, through his Spirit, in the life of the believer. Jesus would tell us in Matthew 7:21, "Not everyone who says to Me Lord, Lord will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter."

If it is true that we all want to go to heaven, everyone planning on going will need to take some time and energy studying the word of God to understand the plan that our Lord has for us.
