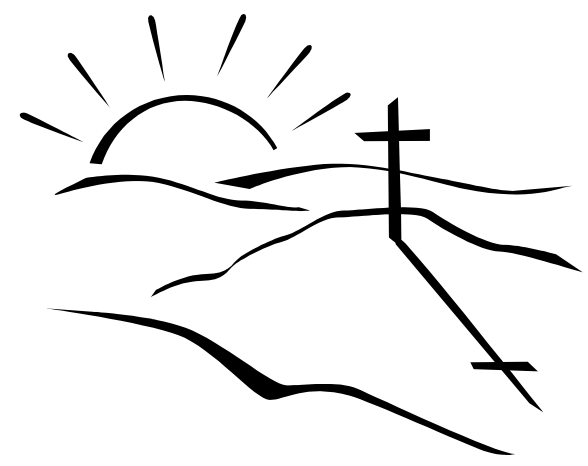

The number one reason some people dislike Valentine's Day is because of the emotional torture they experience if they are not in a "relationship."
