

The Apparel of Women

The passage that we will look at today was not controversial during the first nineteen hundred years of Christianity. Today, however, it is highly controversial. Therefore, we must approach it with caution. One writer called the passage "one of the [New Testament] passages most offensive to contemporary sensitivities. First Timothy 2:9, "Likewise, I want women to adorn themselves with proper clothing, modestly and discreetly, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly garments."

Paul was not commanding women to wear drab clothing. In fact, he indicated that it is all right for a woman to look attractive (Tit. 2:10). Paul did insist that a woman's clothing should not be seductive or ostentatious. In addition to the word "proper," he used the terms "modestly" and "discreetly." Probably, most Christian women in Ephesus could not afford the extravagance Paul mentioned, but some in the congregation were rich (1 Tim 6:9, 10).

In Paul's day, the problem was overdressing. In some parts of the world today, the problem is under-dressing or wearing clothing so form-fitting it leaves nothing to the imagination. No matter how much fashions may change, a woman can always find clothing that most would consider "modest" and "discreet."

Some young women may be unsure what is "modest" and "discreet." In his letter to Titus, Paul instructed older Christian women to teach the younger women (Titus 2:3-5). This presumes that younger women are willing to be taught. If a younger woman has a question about the appropriateness of her clothing, she should talk to an older, mature Christian woman whom she respects.
